## **Points to Ponder**

Give us water!' The steamship replied, 'Lower your buckets where you are.' The captain was furious at this cavalier response but called out again, 'Please, give us water.' But the steamer gave the same reply, 'Lower your buckets where you are!' And with that they sailed away! The captain was beside himself with anger and despair, and he went below. But a little later, when no one was looking, a yeoman lowered a bucket into the sea and then tasted what he brought up: It was perfectly sweet, fresh water! For you see, the ship was just out of sight of the mouth of the Amazon. And for all those weeks they had been sitting right on top of all the fresh water they needed! What we are really seeking is already inside us, waiting to be discovered, waiting to be embraced: The Holy Spirit of God, living within us from the moment of our Baptism.
